Major Hazard and Risks:

- **Electrical Shock and Lightening,**
- **Fire and Carbon Monoxide**
- **Sun-Burn and Heat Exhaustion**
- **Trip Hazard**

Narrative:

1. All CARS members should keep a station log of who is participating from your location.
2. Always have a buddy and check on one another throughout the day for sun, heat-exhaustion, and review safety concerns.
3. No Generators or fires will be in or close proximity to sleeping quarters. Carbon Monoxide is a silent killer.
4. Store Fuel cans out of the sun and away from Generators or sources of ignition.
5. A Fire Extinguisher must be within 25' of all Generators if used..
6. In case of lightening or severe weather, disconnect all antennas, CARS will discontinue Normal Operations. No Personnel will be in the wood-line, Get to open ground. Lightening will travel through the root-systems underneath your feet. When weather has passed, W1JKU will conduct a safety assessment before return to operation.
7. Leave Wildlife and snakes alone.
8. Use Common Sense, Look after your team and if you see an Unsafe Act, Stop it, and report it to HQ when situation allows.
9. All Antennas and Radios shall be grounded.
10. Use Sun Screen, wear a hat to avoid sun-burns.
11. Drink plenty of water (16-32oz per hour in the heat) to avoid becoming a heat casualty.
12. Ensure all wires and trip hazards to marked with engineer tape and Chem lights at night to avoid becoming a trip hazard.
13. Be Safe, have a great day, enjoy giving back to the Community and Remember, you are representing Cherokee County and yourself.
14. Report all Safety Incidents to the safety officer for your station.
