- 3. No Generators or fires will be in or close proximity to sleeping quarters. Carbon Monoxide is a silent killer.
- 4. Store Fuel cans out of the sun and away from Generators or sources of ignition.
- 5. A Fire Extinguisher must be within 25' of all Generators if used..
- 6. In case of lightening or severe weather, disconnect all antennas, CARS will discontinue Normal Operations. No Personnel will be in the wood-line, Get to open ground. Lightening will travel through the root-systems underneath your feet. When weather has passed, W1JKU will conduct a safety assessment before return to operation.
- 7. Leave Wildlife and snakes alone.
- 8. Use Common Sense, Look after your team and if you see an Unsafe Act, Stop it, and report it to HQ when situation allows.
- 9. All Antennas and Radios shall be grounded.
- 10. Use Sun Screen, wear a hat to avoid sun-burns.
- 11. Drink plenty of water (16-32oz per hour in the heat) to avoid becoming a heat casualty.
- 12. Ensure all wires and trip hazards to marked with engineer tape and Chem lights at night to avoid becoming a trip hazard.
