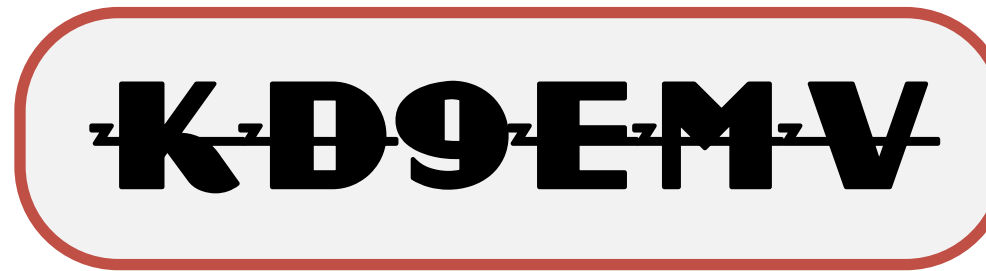
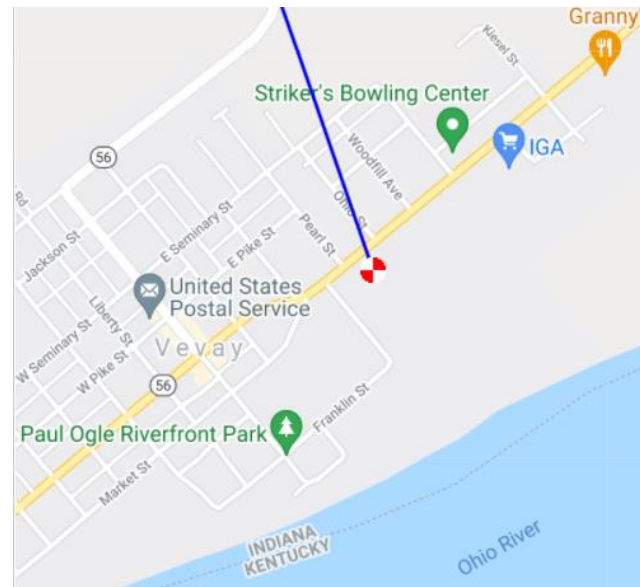

You would respond	November One Foxtrot Delta	N1FD
He answers with	N1FD Three Alpha North Carolina	N1FD 3A NC
You complete your part with	Twenty-nine Alpha New Hampshire, N1FD	29A NH N1FD
He confirms and moves on...	Roger, QRZ Alpha Bravo Four November Charlie	"TU QRZ AB4NC" or "TU AB4NC"

When "running" a frequency (staying on the same frequency and calling CQ), roles are reversed from the above and would go like this:

	Phone	CW
You make a general call	CQ Field Day, CQ Field Day November One Foxtrot Delta	CQ FD N1FD
You listen...and hear	N1FD here is Alpha Bravo Four November Charlie	AB4NC
You respond	Alpha Bravo Four November Charlie Twenty-nine Alpha New Hampshire	AB4NC 29A NH
He answers	"Three Alpha North Carolina" or "Three Alpha North Carolina AA4NC"	"3A NC" or "3A NC AB4NC"
You confirm and move on	Roger, QRZ November One Foxtrot Delta	TU N1FD
You listen, and if no one answers, repeat	CQ Field Day, CQ Field Day November One Foxtrot Delta	CQ FD N1FD

Note: Replace N1FD with KD9EMV – the AB4NC is the received call
