


# W4UA Field Day 2020 Highlights

- 15, 20, 40, 80 meters were about equal
  - 40m SSB was tough, a lot of competition for the airwaves
- Many more 10m QSOs than past years
  - Even a couple of QSOs on 6 meters!
- 2 out of 3 QSOs were 1D and 1E (home stations)
- 70 out of 83 different ARRL / RAC sections worked
- No radio or antenna casualties this year
- We weren't able to put together a GOTA station this year
- Everyone respected the present conditions, tables were sanitized multiple times
- 165 CW QSOs (WF4I and ND4S knocked it out of the park)
- Visitors: City of High Point (P&R), and the HPPD breezed through in the middle of the night (without stopping)
- Media Coverage: George sent out a nice press release; too many other stories in the media that weekend


