1. Trying to get the highest number of contacts and highest overall score (The Contest).
2. Learning about the many facets of ham radio and testing their emergency operating skills (The Training).

There are over 20,000 hams in Michigan. The Livingston Amateur Radio Klub (LARK) and the South Lyon Area Amateur Radio Club (SLAARC) represent many of the hams in our area.

You can find the MI field day sites at the [Field Day Station Locator](#). The LARK Field Day event will be at the Cohoctah Twp Park, 1000 W. Allen Rd, and the site is open to the public from 10 AM Saturday to 2 PM Sunday. Come early or stay late if you like getting your hands dirty.

There will be lots to see and do. The LARK will be coaching for ham radio license testing, and giving the tests on site, for free.

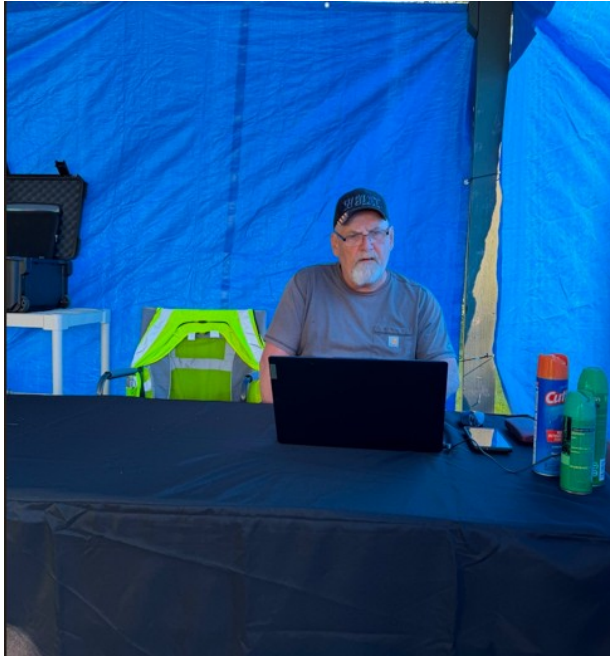

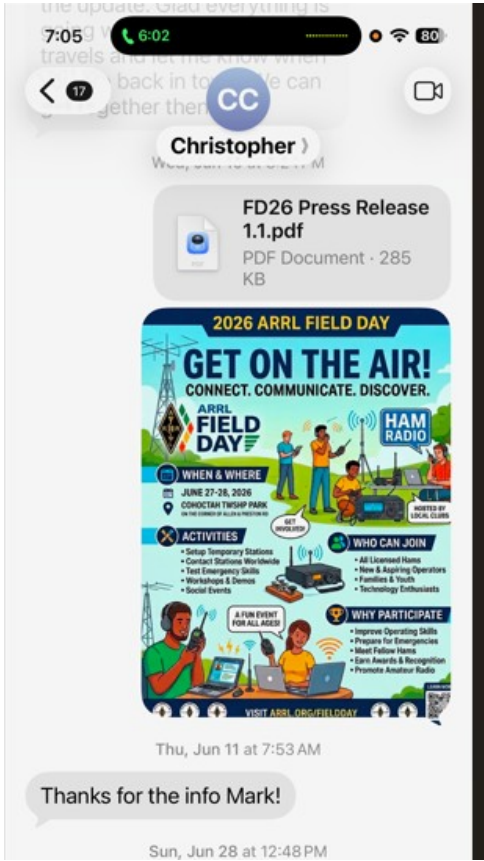

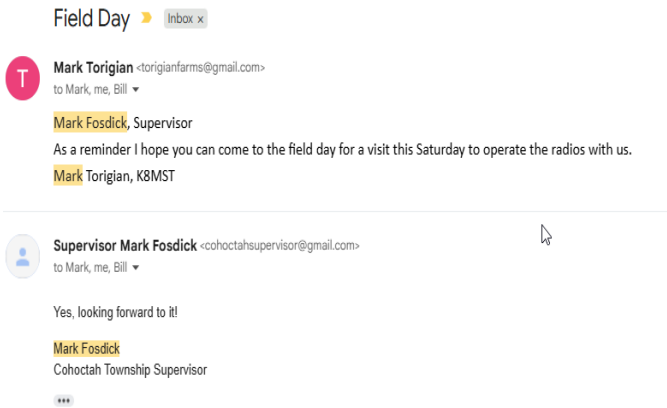

The Safety Officer/s certify by submitting this form that due diligence was made to provide a safe operation.

- ☒ Safety Officer/s or qualified designated assistant/s was on site for the duration of the event.
- ☒ Fuel for generator properly stored.
- ☒ Fire extinguisher on hand and appropriately located.
- ☒ First Aid kit on hand.
- ☒ First Aid - CPR - AED versed ^{else} trained participant/s on site for full Field Day period.
- ☒ Access to NWS alerts to monitor for inclement weather.
- ☒ Tent stakes properly installed and marked.
- ☒ Temporary antenna structures properly secured and marked.
- ☒ Site secured from tripping hazards.
- ☒ Site is set up in a neat and orderly manner to reduce hazards.
- ☒ Stations and equipment properly grounded.
- ☒ Access to a means to contact police/fire/rescue if needed.
- ☒ Safety Officer is designated point of contact for public safety officials.
- ☒ Minimize risks and control hazards to ensure no injuries to public.
- ☒ As necessary, monitoring participants for hydration and ensuring an adequate water supply is available.
