WA7ZZB is back in the woods for Field Day 2022. Skipped last year due to the heat. Being on the other side of 70, that heat was dangerous for setting up and taking down antennas alone. This year running solar powered 1B QRP. Antennas are. 40,30,20 meter offset fed dipole (which at this moment I am using on 15 meters), and a full sized coaxial dipole streched out about 7 foot above the ground. I have two 100 watt solar panels on the camper roof supplemented by a 100 watt portable panel I can orient directly to the sun. Rig is icon 7100 (which is loafing along at QRP) using WZJT-X FT-8 digital mode. If you wantt to visit you are welcome (N46 54.6006', W120 44.1968') but I have room for only one in the camper and this location is at end of paved road then about 5 miles of gravel road then another mile and half of rough dirt road.
